

7.0 ANTICIPATED ENVIRONMENTAL RESULTS

- a) Contaminants contained in the Ambient Air Quality Guidelines in Appendix 1, should be maintained within 66% of the levels set by those guidelines.
- b) Localised ambient air quality is enhanced in those areas where it is currently at unsatisfactory levels. Unsatisfactory levels includes levels between 66% and 100% of the Ambient Air Quality Guideline levels in Appendix 1.
- c) Current levels of localised ambient air quality will be maintained and areas of existing air quality will be protected.
- d) Reduction in the emission of hazardous air contaminants.
- e) Reduction in the number of complaints about discharges of contaminants to air.
- f) Reduction in the levels of offensive or objectionable odour.
- g) Levels of contaminants from discharges to air are consistent with national guidelines and standards for global warming and greenhouse emissions.
- h) Adverse effects on sensitive areas from the discharge of contaminants to air are reduced.
- i) A level of localised and ambient air quality that has adverse effects on human health that are no more than minor.
- j) A level of localised air quality that has no significant adverse effects on amenity values, including significant reductions in visibility.
- k) A level of air quality that has no significant adverse effects on plants and animals, waterways and aquatic ecosystems.
- l) A reduction in the reported cases of off-target adverse effects arising from the application of agrichemical sprays.
- m) Availability of improved information on the effects and sources of discharges of contaminants on ambient air quality.
- n) Improved information and data is available on the state of our air resources.
